There is a <u>pattern</u> for <u>making disciples</u> which Jesus modeled for us.


If we completely understand his message but fail to grasp <u>his methods</u>, we won't truly know the Jesus of the scriptures. Jesus was much more than His words and message.

- *Jesus was deeply committed to relational ministry.
- *He invested in a few intentionally.
- *Jesus often slipped away to pray.
- *He loved sinners profoundly.
- *Jesus balanced his efforts to win the lost, build believers and equip a few workers.



Jesus was fully human, and that distinction is critical.




1st Phase

THE LOST/ SEEKER




- >He <u>spent time</u> with seekers and invited them to 'come and see'.
- >Easy to duplicate.
- >Not difficult but need to be willing.
- >Spiritually dead.
- >Incapable of knowing God.
- >Belong to the ruler of the kingdom of air. (Eph 2:2)

- * Outreach, multiple times.
- * Motivated by Love.
- * Enter their world relationally.
- * Cultivate, plant and pray.




2nd Phase:

BELIEVER


PHASES OF A

- * Meaning to their life and clarity.




3rd Phase:

"FOLLOW ME AND I WILL MAKE YOU FISHERS OF MEN"


LABORER/WORKER/ TEENAGER

- * Relax and enjoy the journey




GO AND BEAR FRUIT (JOHN 15:16)




- >Progression in the relational aspect.

- >Acts 1:8: Making disciples who could make disciples.




Challenge:

- * Variety of ministry callings, but common passion




- Phase 1 **Reach new people.**

Multiplication is our goal.




