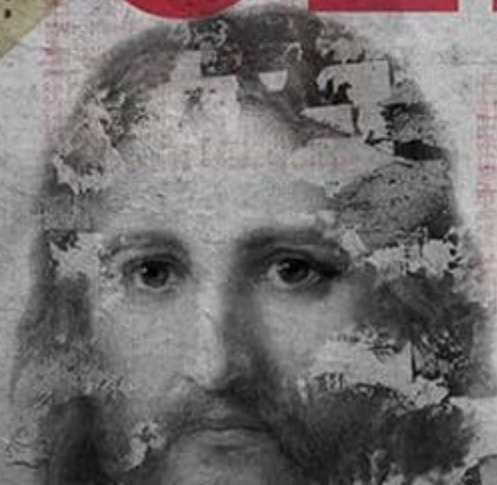

ACTS 15 ³⁶ AFTER SOME TIME PAUL SAID TO BARNABAS, "LET'S GO BACK AND VISIT EACH CITY WHERE WE PREVIOUSLY PREACHED THE WORD OF THE LORD, TO SEE HOW THE NEW BELIEVERS ARE DOING."

MARK, NOT WRITTEN OFF

ACTS 15 ³⁷ BARNABAS AGREED AND WANTED TO TAKE ALONG JOHN MARK. ³⁸ BUT PAUL DISAGREED STRONGLY, SINCE JOHN MARK HAD DESERTED THEM IN PAMPHYLIA AND HAD NOT CONTINUED WITH THEM IN THEIR WORK.

MARK, 'FOUGHT FOR'

ACTS 15 ³⁹ THEIR DISAGREEMENT WAS SO SHARP THAT THEY SEPARATED. BARNABAS TOOK JOHN MARK WITH HIM AND SAILED FOR CYPRUS. ⁴⁰ PAUL CHOSE SILAS, AND AS HE LEFT, THE BELIEVERS ENTRUSTED HIM TO THE LORD'S GRACIOUS CARE. ⁴¹ THEN HE TRAVELED THROUGHOUT SYRIA AND CILICIA, STRENGTHENING THE CHURCHES THERE.
